As per the VTU Special Regulations with regard to Examinations and Assessments for UG and PG Programmes 2020-21 vide letters mentioned in the references 1 & 2 above, students of II semester B.E./M.Tech. who wish to improve their grade in any course of the II semester, which is awarded as per the prescribed procedure notified vide reference 3 will be given ONE ADDITIONAL CHANCE to attend the examination (SEE) and improve their grade.

Such students who wish to improve the grades of II semester courses shall apply as per the schedule given below.

Application forms and payment challan can be collected from Mr. Shyam of Examination Section in main office, exam fee payment can be made in the Bank of Baroda, VVCE Campus and the filled forms are to submitted to Mr. Shyam along with the fee paid challan.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

- 1. Additional chance to improve the grades is applicable ONLY for the II semester CREDIT courses and this chance will not be considered as an additional attempt.
- 2. Who Can Apply?
 - (i) Students who been awarded any grade (except 'S' Grade) for a course in II
 - (ii) Students who have been awarded 'F' Grade in a course because of not having the minimum prescribed average SEE marks of I semester (less than 10 marks out
 - (iii) Students who have been awarded 'F' Grade in a course because of not having prescribed total marks to pass (40 out of 100), but has the minimum prescribed average SEE marks of I semester and minimum prescribed CIE marks in that course in II semester.
- 3. Who cannot Apply? Students who have been awarded 'F' Grade in a course because of not having prescribed minimum CIE marks in a course of II semester are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for that coursee. Such students can register to the supplementary

semester immediately, provided the credits registered to supplementary semester both from the I and II semester is not more than 14 credits.

- 4. As students write exams, the actual regulation for passing a course will prevail. i.e., students should score a minimum of 20 out of 50 marks. Only for such students the improvement in grades, if any, will be considered.
- 5. After writing the SEE, if there is no improvement in the grade of a particular course, then the existing grade of that course will be considered.
- 6. If a student remains ABSENT for the examination in the additional chance, no further chances will be given.
- 7. Exams will be conducted in offline mode and the question papers will have internal choice for each question.
- 8. Gracing Policy will not apply to II semester results as SEE was not conducted and also it is not applicable in the additional chance provided to improve the grade.
- 9. Applications received after the last date will not be considered
