Sub: Procedure for Calculation of Grades of II Semester -AY:2020-21 - reg.

References:

1. VTU, Belagavi Letter No. VTU/BGM/Aca-OS-Cirs/2021-22/1803, dated 03.08.2021
2. VTU Belagavi Letter No. VTU/BGM/Reg(E)/PS/2020-2021/311, dated 05.08.2020

As directed by the Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi vide letters mentioned in the reference above, the below given procedure will be adopted for the calculation of the Grades in the current intermediate semester (II Semester B.E., M. Tech., and MBA) under Autonomous Scheme. The same is notified for the reference of the concerned.

General:

1. Grades of intermediate semesters shall be calculated by giving 50% weightage to CIE of current even semester (II semester) and 50% weightage to SEE of preceding semester (I semester) only. If the marks for CIE and SEE are not 50, marks scored by the student shall be proportionately scaled, up or down.

PROCEDURE FOR CALCULATION OF GRADES OF II SEMESTER

1. Calculation of TOTAL MARKS of a course:

For a Credit Course:

TOTAL MARKS = Average SEE Marks of I Semester + CIE Marks of II Semester

For a Mandatory Non-Credit Course:

TOTAL MARKS = CIE Marks of II Semester

2. Calculation of Average SEE Marks of I Semester:

- i) The SEE marks (excluding CIE marks) scored in each credit course of the I semester shall be tabulated and the average SEE marks shall be calculated.
- ii) If a student has remained absent for SEE in one or more of the courses of the I semester, the SEE marks for those courses shall be taken as zero.
- iii) If the student has appeared more than once for any of the courses of the I semester (SEE and Make-up exams), the best SEE marks of all the appearances shall be considered for calculating the average SEE marks of the I semester.

3. 'FAIL' in a course:

Credit Courses:

A student shall be awarded 'F' Grade in the credit courses of II semester in any of the following cases:

- The minimum required average SEE marks of I semester for passing the courses of II semester shall be taken as 10 out of 50 instead of the normal 20 out of 50. If a student obtains less than 10 out of 50 average SEE marks in the I semester, he/she shall be deemed to have failed in all courses of the II semester and shall be awarded an 'F' Grade for all courses of the II semester.
- A student obtaining less than the minimum prescribed CIE marks (less than 20 out of 50) in any course of the II semester shall be awarded an 'F' grade for that course.
- If the average SEE marks of I semester is equal to or more than 10 out of 50 and the CIE marks in II semester for a course is equal to or more than 20 out of 50, but, the TOTAL MARKS in that course is less than 40 out of 100, then the student is awarded an 'F' Grade for that course.

Mandatory Non-credit Course:

A student shall be awarded 'NP' Grade in the mandatory non-credit course of II semester if the CIE marks of that course in II semester is less than 20 out of 50 irrespective of the average SEE marks of I semester.

4. Awarding Letter Grade:

If a student obtains average SEE marks of I semester equal to or greater than 10 out of 50, CIE marks of II semester in a course equal to or greater than 20 out of 50 and TOTAL MARKS equal to or greater than 40 out of 100 in that course, then, he/she shall be awarded a suitable letter grade as per the below table of our regulations.



