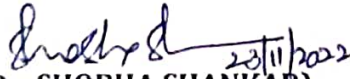
NOTIFICATION

Sub: Vertical Progression of regulations governing the 2021-22 Batch B.E Students

Ref: VTU Notification VTU/BGM/Aca-OS/Cirs/2022-23/4153 dated November 16, 2022

The clauses of Vertical Progression regulations governing B.E. program were amended by VTU vide their circular referred above. The amended Vertical Progression for the students who are admitted to I semester/ I year B. E. program under CBCS-2021 during the academic year 2021-22 is notified as below.

- a. Students have to fulfill the attendance and CIE requirement to appear for SEE of Course/s of 1st Year.
- b. Carryover of backlog courses: From 1st semester till 6th semester the student/s who obtains required attendance, CIE, and appears for SEE but fails (F Grade) to pass a course/s is allowed to move forward to the next semester (odd/even) irrespective of a number of F Grades, including courses Absent for SEE. However, for the award of a degree, the student must pass all the courses as per applicable schemes and regulations and earn the prescribed credits. This is subject to a permitted maximum duration
- c. The student is permitted to seek admission to IV year (7th semester) provided he/she passes all the courses of 1st and 2nd semesters.
- d. The student who fails to satisfy CIE and attendance requirement has to repeat the courses/ equivalent courses as notified by the institution from time to time.
